

Instructions for import from PubMed into Copenhagen Neuropsychology Database

There are many ways to use the database effectively. Some will want to create their own smaller database in some specific research area; others may want to continue with the total database, but personalizing it with own notes and own additions (perhaps in addition to my updates). It is easy to import searched references from PubMed into the database.

PubMed is accessed at <http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/pubmed>. Use advanced search.

Mark the references you want to import

Click: Send to:

Choose destination

Click: file

“Download xx items” appears

Click: Format / Medline

Click: gem/store

Store “pubmed_result” (e.g. in documents ; if you import into reference manager after each search, continue overwriting the previous search result)

In Reference Manager 12, select File (References in earlier versions) / Import Text File

Filter: PubMed (or a modified version hereof*)

Text File: Select the address of your pubmed_result.txt

*)To maintain the placement of single elements of references, you may modify the filter in “Edit Filter”: click

AB > Notes

(AD > Notes) This became problematic with a PubMed change in January 2014)

AU > Authors

DP > Year

IP > Issue

MH > keywords

PG > <source>

TA > Journal name

TI > Title

VI > Volume

In a newly installed Reference Manager program, some abbreviations may not be recognized correctly. To correct this, you may want to include and exclude certain terms.

In Tools, select Import Dictionaries / Periodical Term Dictionary.

Here, delete: Cogn Lang Invest Front Comp Consult Eng Metab Physiol Mov Lond Magn Nor.

Add: CMAJ CNS ANXIETY WEIGHT ECOLOGY ECT EMOTION EPILEPTIC GAIT POSTURE HIV TINNITUS NEUROCASE NEUROGENETICS NEUROPATHOLOGY NEUROTHERAPEUTICS STRESS APHASIOLOGY MEMORY NEUROLOGIST COPING NEUROIMAGE COCHRANE ASSESSMENT ALZHEIMERS DATABASE
